### **PLAYER Code of Ethics**

1. The representative player must be available for the full period of the representative match as described on the Agreement Form.
  2. Selected players agree to participate fully in any competitions, practice sessions, team meetings and official functions arranged for the team and/or as directed by the NDGA VP or his representative.
  3. Representative players agree to abide by and support any sponsorship arrangements made for the team.
  4. Representative players agree at all times to conform to any reasonable instructions or directions of the NDGA Executive or the Team Manager and abide by the NDGA Code of Conduct Policy, including curfew times, a copy of which can be found on [www.ndga.com.au](http://www.ndga.com.au)
  5. Representative players agree to make no press statements or appearances on radio or television without the approval of the NDGA.
  6. Representative players agree that the NDGA or the Team Manager may at any time during the match terminate their membership of the team without being required to give any reason for so doing. Upon any such termination, the player agrees that they shall forthwith return to their home address (Juniors' parents will be contacted re their transport home).
  7. Representative players shall be responsible for the safety of their luggage, clothing and equipment at all times.
  8. Representative players agree that they shall at all times when required, wear the clothing provided by the NDGA unless the Team Manager at his discretion allows other clothing to be worn at specific times.
  9. Representative players agree that any equipment provided to them by the NDGA in good condition must return said equipment to the NDGA immediately after the completion of the match.
  10. Representative players agree that at all times during the event or match described in the agreement and associated training sessions, team meetings and functions, that they shall conduct themselves in a manner befitting a representative of the NDGA and that they shall not bring the name of the Newcastle District Golf Association into disrepute.
